Cancellation/Change Policy:

Cancellations can be accommodated if requested up to 3 days before scheduled camp date. A full refund minus \$50 will be returned. A \$75 cancellation fee will be charged for any cancellations thereafter. There is no charge for changing camp sessions or for medical reasons if requested a week before class schedule starts. A \$25 fee for any changes thereafter.

Disciplinary Policy

Despite the fact that we do not anticipate any disciplinary issues arising during the camp, we must set some important guidelines to ensure that all participants contribute to the safe and healthy atmosphere of the club and the event.

Educational Chess Campers Code of Conduct

1. Every camper is expected to stay within the camp area unless instructed otherwise by a Ms. Diana Durham.
2. Every camper is expected to behave and follow all the rules of the club and in particular of the camp.
3. Every camper is expected to contribute to the well-being and positive atmosphere during the camp at all times.
4. After the 1st disciplinary problem that arises during the camp, which includes but not limited to, disruptive or harmful behaviors, the student will receive a warning and parent notification.
5. After the 2nd disciplinary problem, the student could be expelled from the camp. Camp fee will not be refunded due to expulsion because of behavior.
6. These rules are applicable wherever the day's camp schedule is held.
